We are delighted to inform you that the IDF Life for a Child Programme, in collaboration with the International Society for Pediatric and Adolescent Diabetes (ISPAD), has recently published the **2nd edition of the IDF LFAC/ISPAD Pocketbook Guidelines**.

We first adapted and developed these guidelines using material from the ISPAD Guidelines and other resources. The 1<sup>st</sup> edition was launched at the IDF World Diabetes Congress in Melbourne in 2013.

For this Second Edition, LFAC and colleagues in ISPAD have expanded the Nutrition and Pregnancy chapters and made various other updates so that the Guidelines are completely up-to-date. Flow charts to accompany the Guidelines will follow later in 2017.

We also plan to have the guidelines translated into French, Spanish and Russian.

We will soon be mailing out print copies to all LFAC-supported centres and countries. In the meantime, the Guidelines are available for download from <http://www.idf.org/sites/default/files/LFAC-ISPAD-Pocketbook-2nd-edition-low-res.pdf>.
